NEWS FROM THE CHAIR

As I approach the end of my first year as Chair and I spend time looking back at a very busy and hectic year, I find myself asking, where has the time gone? The various planned activities seem to roll together. The fund raising committee meet and plan, organise then do. Then, what feels like a few weeks later, we start all over again with another fund raising meeting to plan the next event. So a big thank you to all members of the Fund Raising Committee who work so hard all through the year.

We held our Christmas Bazaar at St Mary's church hall on the 18th November 2023 and it rained all day; long, strong winds and very cold, just the sort of day not to go out. Once again a very big thank you to all the Friends who came out to support us and enable us to raise over £800 for the hospital.

This was followed by a very enjoyable Carol singing event for the patients, which was held a couple of days before Christmas Day at Caterham Dene Hospital. Several members of the Friends joined with members of St Luke's Larks, the church choir and members of the Round Table with some musical accompaniment by a trio of musicians from St. Luke's. Cakes were supplied by the Friends for patients, staff and Choristers and the hospital kindly supplied the tea. This is an annual event so if you would like to join us for carols next Christmas, please keep an eye out for details in the autumn edition of the Newsletter.

Our next planned event is our Annual Quiz night. This year it's being held in Caterham Community Association Centre on Saturday 20th April 2024. Details can be found on the front page of this Newsletter. We do hope to see you there.

The Friends will be attending the Caterham Carnival this year which is being held on the 8th June, Westway Common. Free lucky dip for the children and for a small fee, a chance to name and win a large teddy bear. So if you're visiting, pop over to say hello. It's always nice to meet our Friends.

Our Street Collection this year is planned for 29th June, in Church Walk, adjacent to Morrisons. Hope to see you in passing.

Purchases – this year we have paid for the reorganisation of the TV system within the wards and other areas of the hospital and supplied a new 55" TV for the Day room. Other items include six Coffee Tables, two Easy Clean Over Bed Tables and two Vernacare Commodes.

Our latest purchase is four, state of the art Nursing Stations, that connect to the hospital Data Network, allowing a patient's vital sign readings to be recorded automatically against the patient's record. This allows the nurses more time with the patients and less time filling out the paper work. It also eliminates potential errors in recording the vital signs data. They are due for delivery in the next couple of weeks.

These items are in addition to our normal spend at the hospital; daily newspapers, slipper-socks and welfare packs (soap, flannel, toothbrush and paste) for the ward and therabands for the Physio Department. We continue to liaise with the hospital on requests for equipment and facilities for the patients.

TREASURER'S REPORT

DRAFT ANNUAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 29 FEBRUARY 2024

Our annual accounts are currently being finalised and will be presented for discussion at the AGM on 16 May 2024. For your information a summarised version of the draft accounts is set out below and if you have any questions or if you would like to receive a full copy of the annual accounts once they are confirmed by the Independent Examiner, then please contact me at treasurer@focdh.co.uk or come along to the AGM.

Total receipts in the year were over £31,000 up by 38% when compared to last year. We were very fortunate to receive a large legacy from a local Caterham resident and also benefitted from a significant increase in interest received on our bank balance. Due to the great efforts of the shop volunteers, income from our hospital shop was over £4,500.

Friends were able to provide £40,000 of new equipment to the hospital in 2023, while also providing £9,000 of amenities for patients. Since 2010 Friends has provided over £483,000 of funding to the hospital.
